4. Assist teachers and students in making relevant connections in the community
5. Document ongoing and new service learning activities
6. Develop service learning as an instructional and assessment practice

#### Building Rep. Job Description

#### Service Learning Building Reps will:

- Support building teachers in their efforts to adapt potential service learning projects, especially in the brainstorming and planning stages.
- Support documentation of service learning projects through photography or bulletin boards or press releases, etc., within their school, as well as on a district level.
- Promote professional development opportunities such as workshops to building faculty.
- Promote service learning opportunities that exist with outside community partners to building faculty.
- Attend Service Learning Steering Committee meetings and share updates on building service learning projects as well as share concerns and needs.
- Be available to consult on service learning projects as they progress.
- Make KIDS Consortium materials available for planning, execution, and reflection stages of service learning projects (checklist).
- Attend professional development sessions (ex. Train the Trainer).
