

- Take I-395 North to Exit 4 (Seminary Road West)
- Go west on Seminary Road for three traffic lights
- Turn right on Beauregard Street
- Take the second light and turn left into the college
- Go up the hill and turn right onto Dawes Avenue

From the North, Arlington and D.C.

- Take I-395 South to Exit 5 (King Street West)
- Turn left onto Beauregard Street
- Turn right into the college
- Go up the hill and turn right onto Dawes Avenue

What is Drive to Employment?

Drive to Employment is an innovative service learning program at Northern Virginia Community College (NOVA). Automotive students gain valuable real world experience by performing free vehicle services for clients of local community organizations.

How Can Drive to Employment Help Me?

Drive to Employment students are capable of performing a variety of services on your vehicle. The labor is free and all you need to do is provide the parts. That's right, the labor is free! Local automotive repair shops charge around \$90 an hour. Not only will NOVA help keep your car running, our students also help you save a lot of money!



How do I Get an Appointment with Drive to Employment?

Each community organization partnered with NOVA's Drive to Employment program refers their client's in need of vehicle services to NOVA. You will need to speak with your case manager about your car troubles and they will help determine if the Drive to Employment program is appropriate for your needs.



Next, your case manager will send a referral to NOVA and you will call or email the Drive to Employment instructor to get your appointment scheduled.

After confirming your appointment, all you will need to do is show up at the date and time of your appointment with your car.

List of Possible Services:

- Vehicle Inspection
- Diagnosis of Check Engine Light, Unusual Noises or Smells, and Engine Performance Problems
- Tire Services
- Brake Services
- Oil Leak Diagnosis and Repairs
- Cooling System Diagnosis and Repairs
- Water Pump, Radiator, Thermostat, and Hose Replacement
- Belt Adjustment and Replacement



- Oil and Filter Change
- Engine Coolant Flush
- Transmission Fluid Replacement
- Differential Fluid Replacement
- Air Filter and Cabin Filter Replacement
- Spark Plug Replacement
- 4 Wheel Alignment
