- **Cohort Coordinator**

Manage ID117 students at designated sites: complete sign in and check-out, maintain and promote positivity and professionalism among students. Minimum of four hours per week.

Block of 2 hours per week teaching in your area, plus one hour-long meeting per week with faculty member, one with other instructors, two hours of lesson preparation and reflection (minimum of five hours/week). By application – limited to 16 teachers/area.

Coordinate all aspects of dance, music, art, or mentoring program. Block of two hours/week teaching plus two hour-long meetings/week (one with student instructors, one with faculty member), four hours per week of organizational service (recruiting, lesson plans, recordkeeping), two hours of lesson preparation, grand total of 10 hours/week. By application – one student will be selected/area.

Dance Instructor - Extensive dance experience

Must have taken formal music instruction for at least one continuous year. Must have experience in arranging, performing, and teaching multiple styles.

Experience in instructing arts and crafts is preferred. Must provide portfolio of both visual art and crafts.

Support art lessons under supervision of the Boys & Girls Club Art teacher (no teaching experience necessary).
